The University offers specializations in LL.M. Programme. However, depending upon the minimum number (10) students, availability of subject teacher and other conditions, the University may or may not offer any particular specialization. The candidate taking admission to the Programme shall have to keep these conditions in mind.

All the above candidates are required to send scan (pdf) copies of their B.A.LL.B.(Hons.)/LL.B. marks sheet or equivalent examination on or before June 20, 2019 by email at [admission@nludelhi.ac.in](mailto:admission@nludelhi.ac.in) or

in person so as to enable the University to decide inter-se merit of the candidates securing same marks in AILET 2019. **In the event of non-declaration of the result, the candidates shall sign an undertaking in the prescribed proforma.** The candidates are required to attend the spot counselling session for the admission to LL.M. (One Year) Degree Programme at 10:00 am sharp on June 24, 2019 in the Auditorium, National Law University, Delhi, and Mark their Attendance. The counselling process will be start at 11:00 a.m. After start of counselling process, no student will be allowed to participate in the counselling process. The candidates not present at the time of spot counselling for any reason shall not be considered for admission and the seat will be offered to the next candidate as per the merit list. The results of the Spot Counselling will be announced on the spot. The candidates are required to bring the following documents for Spot Counselling:

1. Self attested copy of Marks Statement of B.A.LL.B.(Hons.)/LL.B. or equivalent & 10th and 12th class Examination
2. Self attested copy of Character Certificate from the University/College last attended.
3. Self attested copy of Transfer Certificate
4. Demand Draft of Rs.50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand Only) drawn in favour of "Registrar, National Law University, Delhi", payable at Delhi. The candidates who are selected for provisional admission in Spot Counselling will be required to pay the full fee by July 1, 2019, failing which the provisional admission will automatically stand cancelled and the fee deposited will be forfeited. Any vacancy arising at later stage shall be filled up from the waiting list drawn from the candidates present in the Spot Counselling. The detailed fee structure is attached at **Annexure "A"**. The candidates attending the Spot Counselling shall have to make their own arrangements for travel and stay. It may be noted that due to space constraints, the National Law University, Delhi will not provide the Hostel facilities to male students admitted in the LL.M. Programme. However, the girl students from outside Delhi/NCR region may be considered for allotment of hostel accommodation subject to availability and hostel fee will be deposited by concerned student separately.

**Foreign Nationals:** The annual tuition fee shall be in Indian Rupees equivalent to 5,000 (Five Thousand Only) US Dollars for candidates from SAARC countries and 10,000 (Ten Thousand Only) US Dollars from other countries. Other fees will be same as applicable to Indian students.

In addition to above, Mess advance INR 21000.00 per semester will be paid by the students to be adjusted as per actual charges/expenses of the Hostel Mess. The amount may be increased after reviewing the actual expenses on the recommendations of Mess Committee, if required, with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor.

\*50% of the deposits remaining after dues will go towards Student Welfare Fund and 50% towards Alumni on completion of the course. The Student Welfare Fund and Alumni Fund shall be kept in a separate accounts and will be used only for students & alumni.
